2.05.2 Communications

Position Reporting

Add:- After the Fastnet Rock add Bishop Rock 006° 26' .74W

2.06 Identity Check

Add: - IMOCA Open 60 boats shall pass through one of the gates with mainsails reefed to the minimum and storm jibs set.

2.14 Exceptional start to east (red flag at RYS)

Delete:

Inner Limit (which may not be on the starting line) Rolex buoy (yellow tetrahedron about 3.3 cables from the RYS flagstaff in approximate position 50° 46'.28N 001° 17'.62W).
